

The colossal astronomical clock, a masterpiece by Auguste Lucien Vérité, reaches 5 m in height and weighs in at 2 tonnes.

Its 30,000 parts and 60 dials display no fewer than 122 interrelated indications. As well as marking the passing hours, the clock provides information on changes in the sky, the relative positions of the Sun and the Moon, the constellations of the zodiac, the length of day and night, the phase of the moon, the dates of eclipses, tides and solstices, and solar time, among other things.

Visitors can explore the finer details of this ingenious mechanism.
